AMBULANCE MILLAGE RESOLUTION

At a meeting of the Three Oaks Township Board held at the Township Hall at 6810 US 12 West, Three Oaks, Michigan 49128 on the ____ day of _____, 2020, commencing at _____ p.m.

WHEREAS, the Three Oaks Township Board wishes to provide ambulance services for Three Oaks Township and Three Oaks Village; and

WHEREAS, townships may provide for ambulance services, as authorized by Public Act 8, Extra Session of 1967 as amended (MCL 124.531 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, townships may contract and cooperate with other entities to provide ambulance services as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

WHEREAS, townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

WHEREAS, the Three Oaks Township Board wishes to increase its levy to 1 mill for ambulance services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Three Oaks Township Board, Berrien County, Michigan, approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the August 4, 2020 election ballot:

AMBULANCE MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall Three Oaks Township impose an increase of 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution and levy it on real property for a period of four years, 2021 through 2024 inclusive, for the purpose of providing ambulance services for building maintenance and expenses and including basic life support ambulance service for Three Oaks Township including Three Oaks Village 24 hours a day, 365 days per year pursuant to a contract for services.? It is estimated the revenue collected by Three Oaks Township as a result of this proposal will be \$97,734.00 in the first year the millage is levied based on the most recent taxable value.
