

This notice is to inform all residents within Three Oaks Township, including the Village of Three Oaks, that effective March 11, 2019 the Residential Recycling Collection Service, that has been provided by Three Oaks Township, will discontinue.

Since 2012 through March of 2018 the recycling program was made available from grants from the Pokagon Fund. In March of 2018 Three Oaks Township was informed by the Pokagon Fund that funding was no longer available for this program. The Three Oaks Township Board of Trustees realizes the importance of recycling and decided to fund the recycling for one (1) year, March 2018 thru March 2019, through our General Fund while searching for other available grants. The Township was unsuccessful in this search. Because of decreasing revenue the difficult decision was made to discontinue the recycling program.

The Three Oaks Township Board of Trustees encourages the residents to continue with their recycling with Lakeshore Recycling but as a private customer. The containers, that have been provided by the Township, will become property of the homeowner. Information regarding the change in service will be forthcoming from Lakeshore Recycling.
